Changes to Choirs

Altar Servers

There will be an altar server meeting for all current altar servers and for anyone who wishes to become an altar server. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 22nd at 7:15 PM, immediately following Adoration and Benediction. Current servers need to bring their cleaned albs with them if they need to be exchanged for the next size up.

To become an altar server, you must be 10 years old or in 4th grade and you must have received the Sacrament of Communion.

Liturgy Committee

The liturgy committee will be meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 29th at 7:15 PM in the Liturgy Office. The coordinator from each liturgical ministry or a representative needs to be present. Finalized calendars will be handed out.

Changes

As you may have noticed there are some changes around the church. One change is the cross on the altar. It has been replaced with a smaller cross. Fr. Creedon has asked for this change so that everyone can see the action during the Eucharistic Prayer.

In addition to that, Fr. Creedon has asked that the gifts be placed on a small table at the entrance of the Church so that they can be brought up at all Masses, both daily and weekend Masses.

And finally, beginning on October 1st, we will no longer be saying the Hail, Holy Queen before the closing song. We will now say it after the closing song for those people who choose to stay until the end of the singing. It will be led by the choir/cantor. The Salve Regina will be sung after the 9 AM Sunday Mass. Recitation of the Hail, Holy Queen at daily Mass will be at the discretion of the celebrant.

Coming soon...Communion under both kinds will resume in October.

Nuestra fe, esperanza y amor están expresados concretamente en la manera en que vivimos. La celebración de los Sacramentos, especialmente la Misa, es el centro de nuestras vidas como Católicos Cristianos, ya que es en la Misa donde celebramos nuestra salvación en Jesús y que El nos nutre con Su Palabra y nos alimenta con Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Si, **los creyentes verdaderos viven su fe asistiendo a Misa cada domingo.** Un Católico que falla en hacer esto no está siendo fiel al Señor, no viviendo—no practicando— lo que Jesús nos enseñó, lo que creemos

Para demostrar que son fieles, Católicos practicantes, se les urge a los feligreses que se registren en la parroquia, que asistan a la Misa semanalmente, y que contribuyan al apoyo económico de la parroquia

Personas con el deseo de recibir el Sacramento de Matrimonio, el bautismo para sus hijos, o servir como padrinos de Bautismo o de Confirmación tienen que ser fieles Católicos practicantes. - Los padres y padrinos tienen que asistir a una charla preparatoria.

PRIMERAS COMUNIONES Y CONFIRMACIONES

- La Primera Comunión se recibe a la edad de siete años (2º Grado), y la Confirmación en el 8º Grado.

MATRIMONIOS
