

PASTOR'S CORNER

Brothers and sisters,

This weekend our Finance Council makes our fiscal report for last year and our 2011 budget available in the bulletin and website. Please take the time to study this important matter.

Just as our families, our parish has been affected by the economic crisis in recent years. The severe weather, cost of snow removal, program and facilities requirements have left the parish with a loan to the diocese and an accumulated deficit of \$140,000.

The good news is that we have a balanced budget for next year and a new and improved accounting system. We have also cut administrative costs. Our school enrollment has grown to 245.

We need the active involvement of every parishioner. I ask you to prayerfully consider your commitment to the parish through your regular offertory giving. Our Festival increased its support to the parish by 16 % from last year's festival. Let us be equally generous with our offertory. Please consider the Faith Direct program, which enables us to give electronically and is weather-proof. I intend to make a financial commitment personally to this great parish and hope each of you will join me in this sacrifice. Be generous with Holy Family, and Holy Family in turn will be generous with our service to you and to all in need. Please increase your giving if you are able, and always remember that "God loves a cheerful giver." - 2 Cor. 9:7

The Hail Holy Queen and the Hail Mary are beautiful prayers that have been rendered in hymn form as the "Salve Regina" and "Gentle Woman". They will be made part of the musical repertoire of Holy family.

Nuestra fe, esperanza y amor están expresados concretamente en la manera en que vivimos. La celebración de los Sacramentos, especialmente la Misa, es el centro de nuestras vidas como Católicos Cristianos, ya que es en la Misa donde celebramos nuestra salvación en Jesús y que El nos nutre con Su Palabra y nos alimenta con Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Si, **los creyentes verdaderos viven su fe asistiendo a Misa cada domingo.** Un Católico que falla en hacer esto no está siendo fiel al Señor, no viviendo—no practicando— lo que Jesús nos enseñó, lo que creemos

Para demostrar que son fieles, Católicos practicantes, se les urge a los feligreses que se registren en la parroquia, que asistan a la Misa semanalmente, y que contribuyan al apoyo económico de la parroquia
