Altar Servers - Just a reminder, check your email regarding changes to the altar server teams and the procedures concerning location during the Eucharistic prayer, and the use of bells and incense. Remember that the bells and incense will only be used at the 9 AM Mass on Sunday.

To become an altar server, you must be 10 years old or in 4th grade and you must have received the Sacrament of Communion.

We Remember... During the month of November, we will be honoring those who have gone before us. If you have a picture of a loved one who has died and would like them displayed, please send it to Kelly Kingett with your name, phone number and address on the back. It will be displayed during the month of November on the bulletin board outside the Liturgy office.

Reserved Signs-Please do not sit in the pews marked with the reserved signs. They are there for our lectors and their families. The seats on the opposite side are reserved for handicapped parishioners and their families.

Father Creedon has asked me to report on the status of the changes that have been made recently, and to perhaps answer some concerns that have arisen in regard to these changes. Here are some, other will follow in the next bulletin.

To ring or not to ring, that is the question. The use of bells is an option in the General Instruction for the Roman Missal. It is up to the discretion of the priest whether or not to use them. Fr. Creedon would prefer that we didn't use them, but has agreed to maintain the use of the bells for the 9 AM Mass and for special liturgies like holy days and Confirmation. This is the latest change for the parish, and many of you are concerned about this change; so much so, in fact, that Father has listened to your concerns and has come up with this solution.

Incense. Likewise the use of incense is an option. Because two of our priests are sensitive to it, Father has chosen to leave the use of the incense up to the discretion of the priest who is celebrating Mass. Incense will still be used at Solemn feasts like Midnight Mass, Holy Thursday, and Easter Vigil as well as Confirmation and funerals.

Salve Regina. The Salve Regina is now being sung at the 6:30 PM, 7:30 AM, and 9 AM Masses following the closing hymn. This chant can be found on the inside of the back cover of all hymnals.

Please consider helping!....From a fellow parishioner:

I am a single father in the Army. I just recently obtained custody of my kids ages 13, 12 and 8. As a single parent in the Army I am required to have a Family Care Plan to designate who will be responsible for taking care of my kids if I am called away for a deployment, training that is outside of the local area or over 24 hours, if something should happen and I am hospitalized or some other event that causes me to be unable to care for my children. The unit I am in is one that doesn't deploy but if a disaster happens like with Haiti I could be sent to assist. I am required to have a short term care provider and a long term care provider. I already have the long term care provider designated but I need someone in the local area for the short term. Typically, that would be for a week or two at most. If I would be gone an extended period of time and not have enough time to have my kids transported to my long term care provider before I had to leave the short term care provider would have them until they could be picked up by my family or flown back to Minnesota. I would be responsible for picking up the expense for food, transportation, etc. for the children.

Nuestra fe, esperanza y amor están expresados concretamente en la manera en que vivimos. La celebración de los Sacramentos, especialmente la Misa, es el centro de nuestras vidas como Católicos Cristianos, ya que es en la Misa donde celebramos nuestra salvación en Jesús y que El nos nutre con Su Palabra y nos alimenta con Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Si, **los creyentes verdaderos viven su fe asistiendo a Misa cada domingo.** Un Católico que falla en hacer esto no está siendo fiel al Señor, no viviendo—no practicando— lo que Jesús nos enseñó, lo que creemos

Para demostrar que son fieles, Católicos practicantes, se les urge a los feligreses que se registren en la parroquia, que asistan a la Misa semanalmente, y que contribuyan al apoyo económico de la parroquia

Personas con el deseo de recibir el Sacramento de Matrimonio, el bautismo para sus hijos, o servir como padrinos de Bautismo o de Confirmación tienen que ser fieles Católicos practicantes.
